An appendix translates Poirot's French and defines the British idiomatic words and phrases that give Christie's novels so much of their flavor.

writings. As well, different perspectives on many of the perplexing mysteries within her mysteries
are provided. Finally, Guide is not an alphabetical list of stories or characters. Instead, it lists many
entrancing errors of sketches and text with comments explaining where possible the reasons for
their existence. Most importantly, Guide does not betray any book's endings nor the identity of the
villain, a rule that genuine Christie devotees always try to uphold.
